One example of the projects about which you would be informed is the Quakertown Community Education Foundation, (QCEF). The mission of the foundation is to provide unique and meaningful educational experiences for students in our school district. Over the past few years the foundation has sponsored programs in the arts and humanities.

One program honors Miss Anna Neamand, who was a QHS graduate and a respected teacher of social studies. For the past four years, a guest resource person who represents the social studies has spent a day with high school students and has given a public presentation. On May 22 our Neamand Series special speaker, former Congressman Jim Greenwood, was our guest speaker. There was a public presentation at 3:30 in the high school cafeteria.

Another program is structured around several paintings owned by the school district by the distinguished local artist, Walter Emerson Baum. Our Baum program last year "Walter E. Baum Remembered" reached through the school district and gave new insights into the work of artists and art restoration. Several Baum paintings have been restored, and will be displayed permanently in the high school.

The QCEF has a speaker's bureau available and the high school offers tours to class reunions of the current Quakertown Elementary School located on 7th Street, the former Quakertown High School, and the current high school on Park Avenue.
