

## **Redistricting Update: Letters sent to parents**

### **How do I know if my children will change schools based on the proposed redistricting plan?**

You will receive a letter. On Friday, January 23, 2015, letters were mailed to families who will have a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and/or 3<sup>rd</sup> grade student next year who will change schools under the proposed plan.

Letters are currently being prepared to families who will have a 4<sup>th</sup> and/or 5<sup>th</sup> grade student next year who will attend a different middle school for 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Remember that next year's 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders can choose to stay in their current school or change to their new school. Either way, however, their middle school in 6<sup>th</sup> grade will be determined by their new school on the map.

**Please note:** At the various redistricting meetings at the elementary schools, some issues were raised about specific streets or neighborhoods along borders, and those issues are currently being evaluated. It is possible that some additional notification letters will need to be sent depending on the outcome of that re-evaluation. Generally speaking, however, if you did not receive a letter, your child's elementary school of attendance is not expected to change.
