



Q.1: How sure are you that you can do well in school right now?





Q.2: Are you getting all the help you need with your schoolwork right now?



Q.3: Are there any subjects you need help with right now? You can pick more than one.





Q.4: How happy are you with how much time you spend in specials or enrichment (art, music, PE, etc.)?







Q.2: How often do you think about what someone of a different race, ethnicity, or culture experiences?





Q.4: At your school, how often are you encouraged to think more deeply about race-related topics?








Q.5: When there are major news events related to race, how often do adults at your school talk about them with students?





Q.1: How would you like to be learning right now?













Q.1: How much effort are you putting into your classes right now?





Q.2: How difficult or easy is it for you to try hard on your schoolwork right now?






Q.3: How difficult or easy is it for you to stay focused on your schoolwork right now?


Q.4: If you have missed in-person school recently, why did you miss school? You can pick more than one.



Q.1: Are there adults at your school whom you can go to for help if you need it right now?





Q.2: How connected do you feel to the adults at your school right now?


