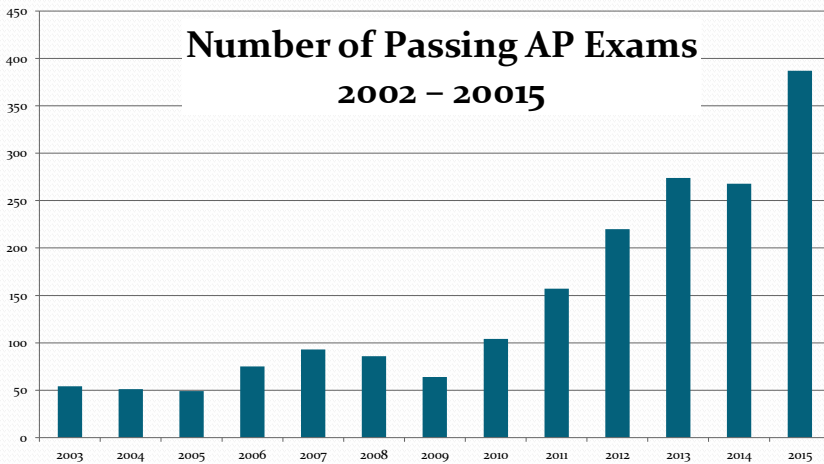

2002 - 2015**



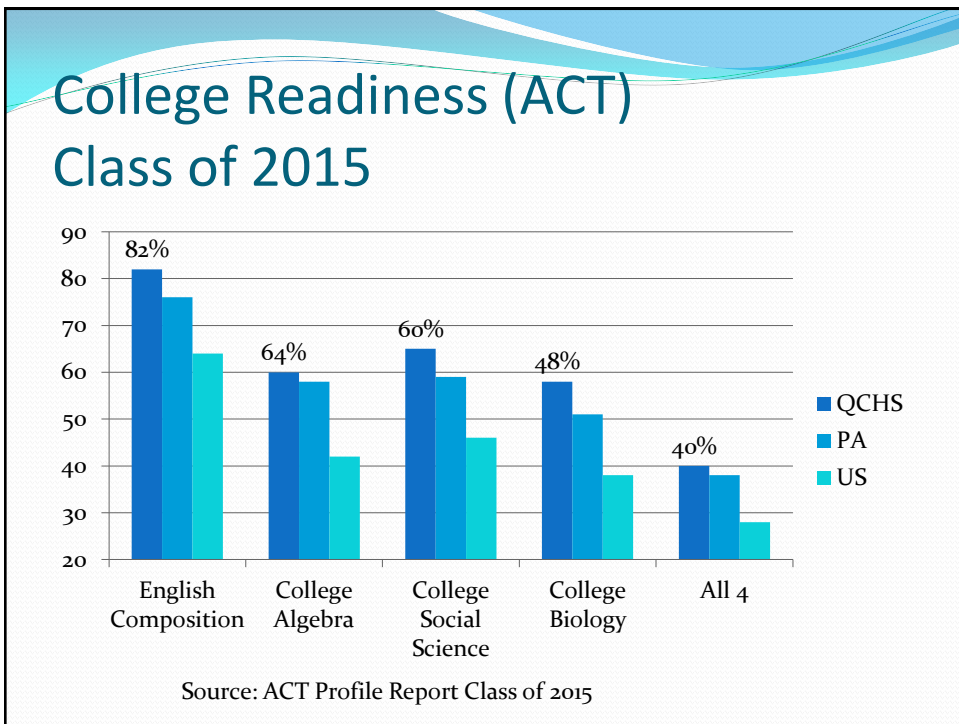
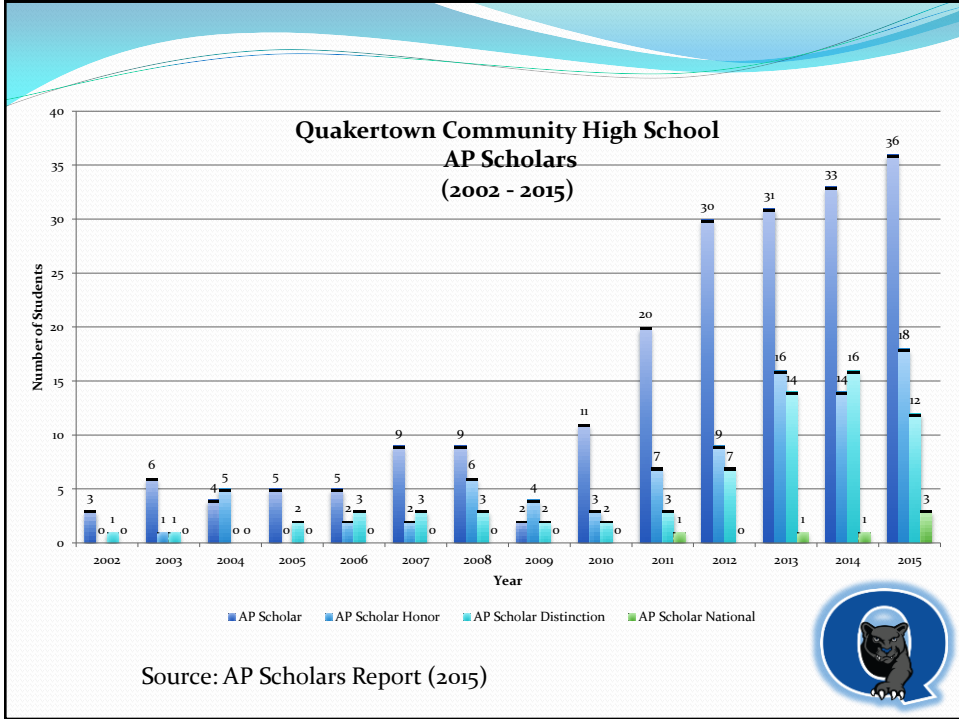

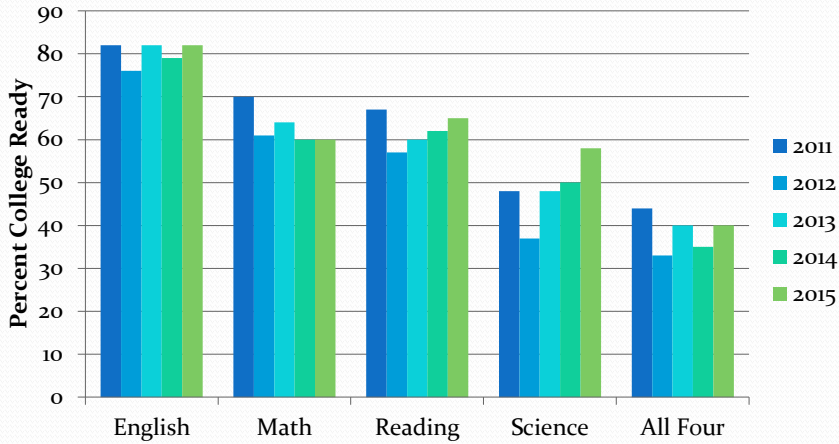

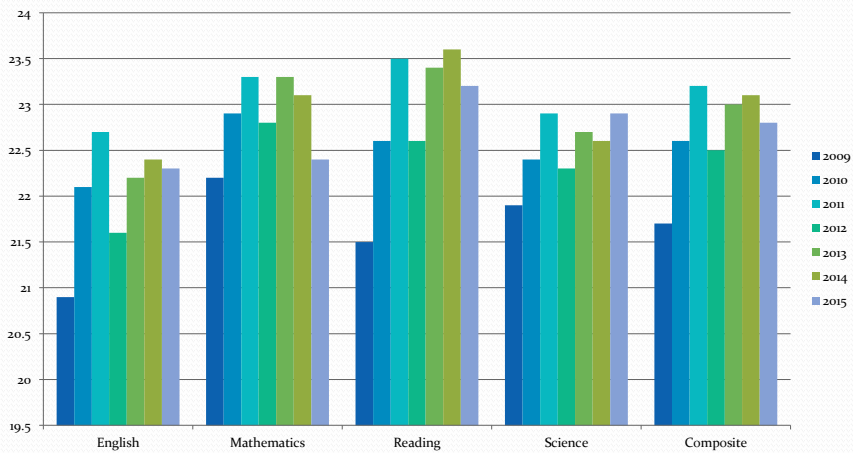


ACT Trends – College Readiness

ACT Trends – Average Score



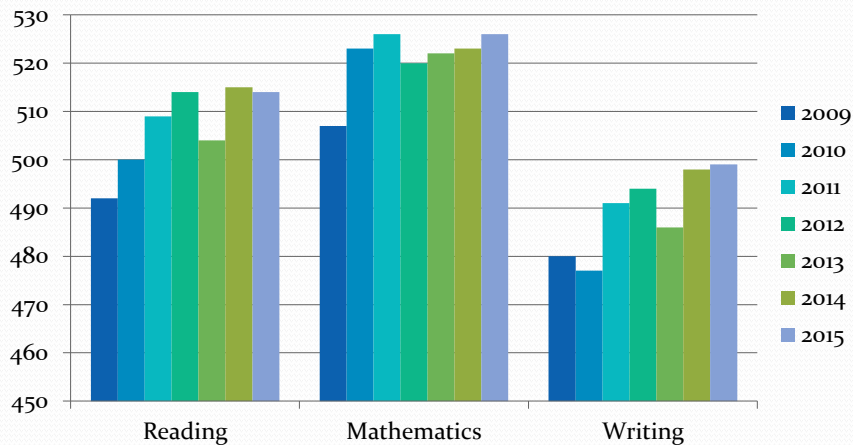
