DISTRICT & COMMUNITY

Quakertown is a rural/residential community located in Bucks County, approximately 50 miles north of Philadelphia. It encompasses three townships and three boroughs covering approximately 72 square miles with a population of 30,000.

The Quakertown Community School District serves approximately 5450 students. It consists of six elementary schools, two middle schools, and one high school which includes a freshman center.

QUAKERTOWN COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL

Quakertown Community High School offers a four-year comprehensive program including access to Career and Technical Education with Upper Bucks County Technical School. The 2015-2016 enrollment is 1678 students with 396 members of the Class of 2016. QCHS operates on a traditional semester schedule with seven 45 minute periods.

CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGES

The transcript reports both an unweighted and weighted GPA. Both cumulative GPAs are computed at the close of each school year and include all graded courses, 9-12. The weighted GPA reflects the appropriate scale factor for all designated classes receiving a grade of 'C' or better. Class rank is based upon weighted GPA and is shown as both numeric rank and percentile.
